

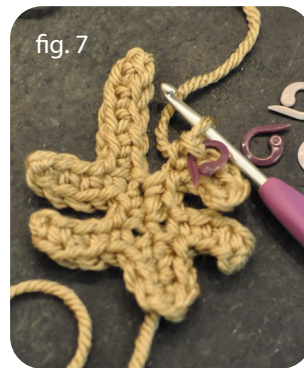

~ moose antler pattern ~

Using Golden Yarn, loosely ch 11 (this will be the foundation chain).

Rnd 1: Starting in 2nd ch from hook and working in back ridge loops; sc 5, ch 5 (*figs. 1, 2*). Starting in 2nd ch from hook and working in back ridge loops, sc 4 (*fig. 3*). In back ridge loops of foundation chain; sc 2, ch 5 (*fig. 4*). Starting in 2nd ch from hook and working in back ridge loops, sc 4. In back ridge loops of foundation chain; sc 2, sc 3 in back ridge loop of last foundation chain (*fig. 5*). Turn work so front loops of foundation chain are facing up. Starting in next ch and working in front loops; sc 2, ch 5 (*fig. 6*). Starting in 2nd ch from hook and working in back ridge loops, sc 4. In front loops of foundation chain; sc 2, ch 5. Starting in 2nd ch from hook and working in back ridge loops, sc 4. Place marker (*fig. 7*).

Rnd 2: Sc 1 in each sc around, ending at place marker (*fig. 8*). Sl st in next sc and tie off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



Using the leftover yarn tail and with the RS of the antler piece facing up (*fig. 9*), fold and sew just the edges of each antler prong and the antler base together using a whip stitch (*figs. 10-12*). Lightly stuff before closing up the center of the antler with a whip stitch (*figs. 13, 14*). Use the remaining yarn tail at the base of the antler to attach antler to head.
