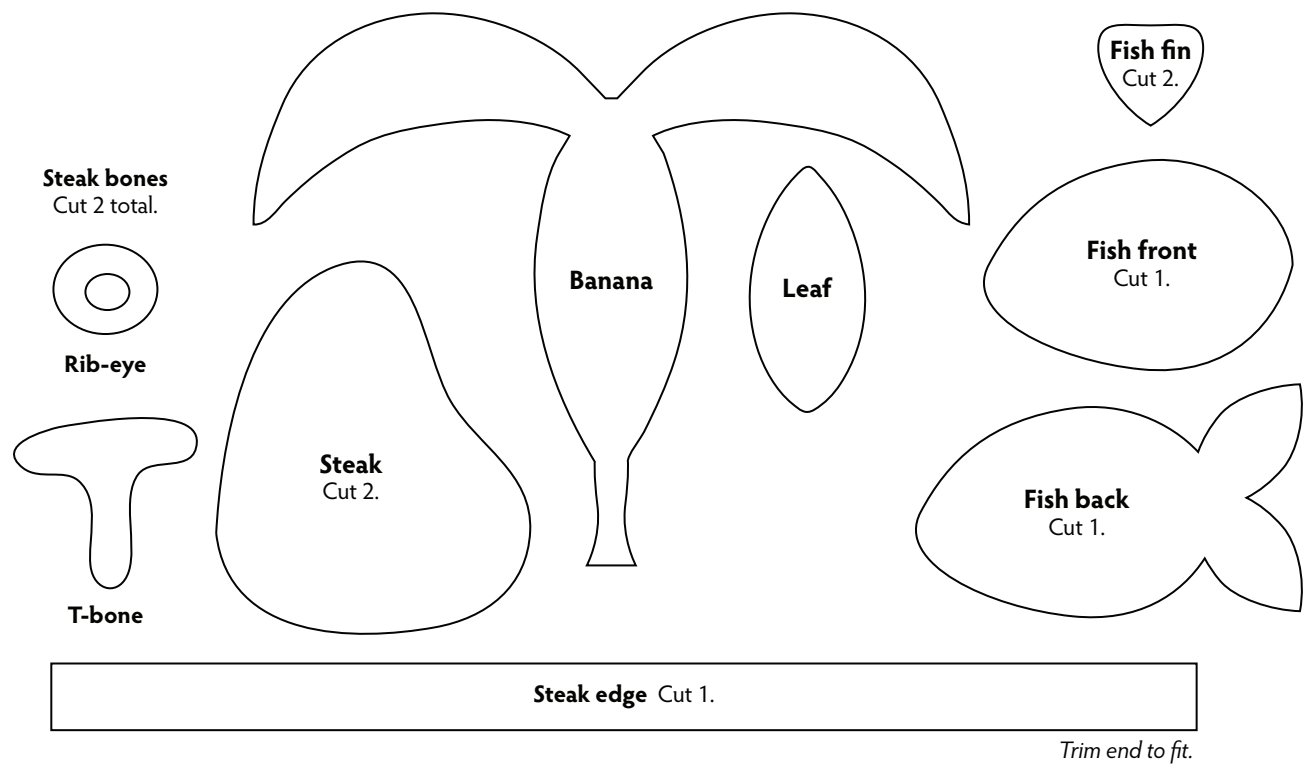
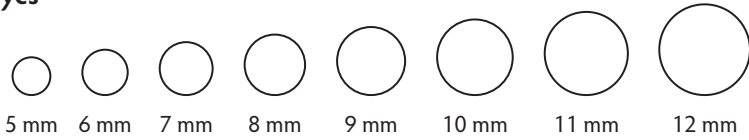


Crochet a Zoo Patterns

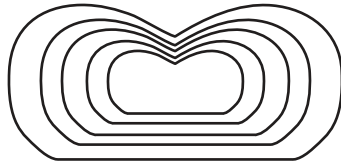

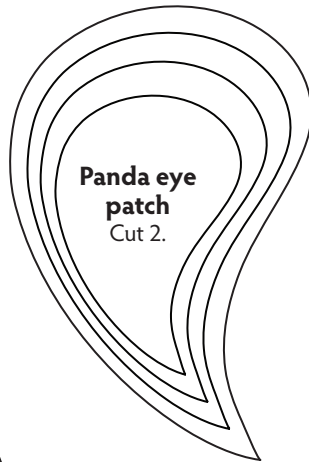


Multiple Pattern Sizes

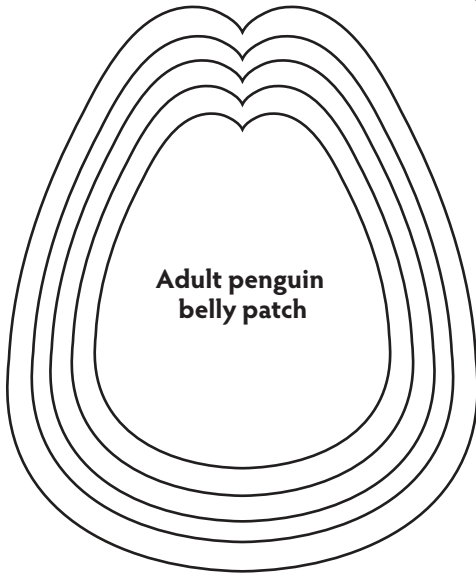
Baby penguin patch



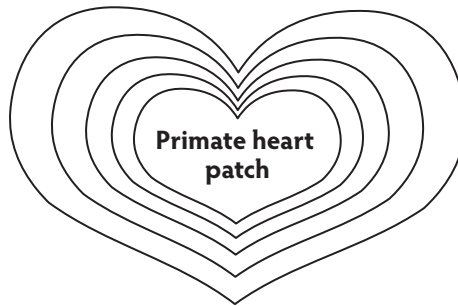
Panda eye patch

Adult penguin belly patch



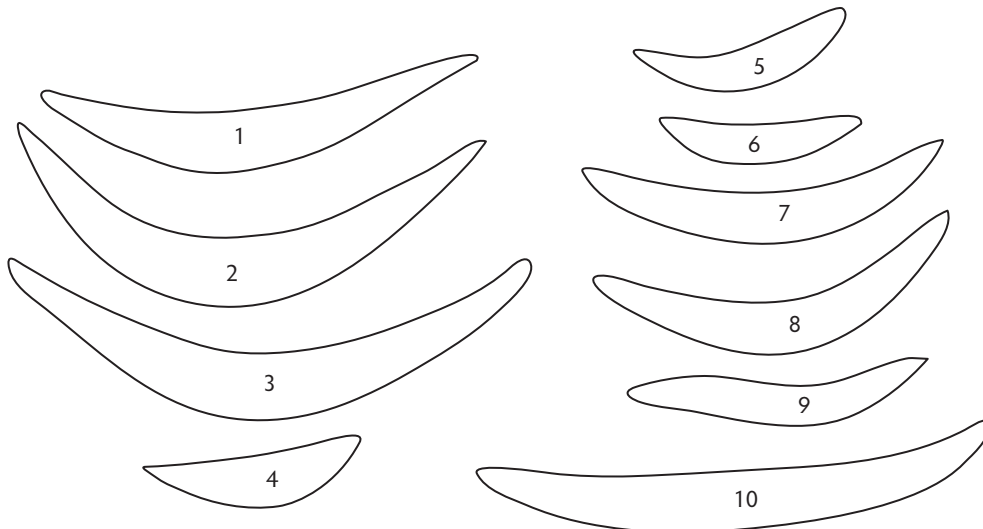

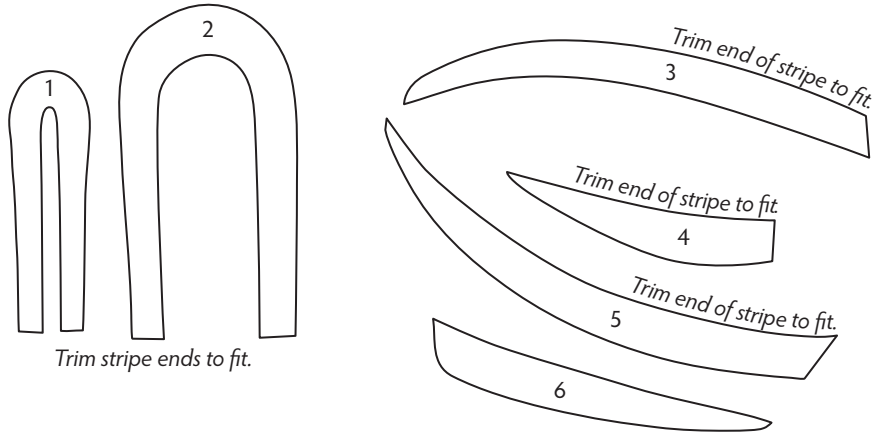

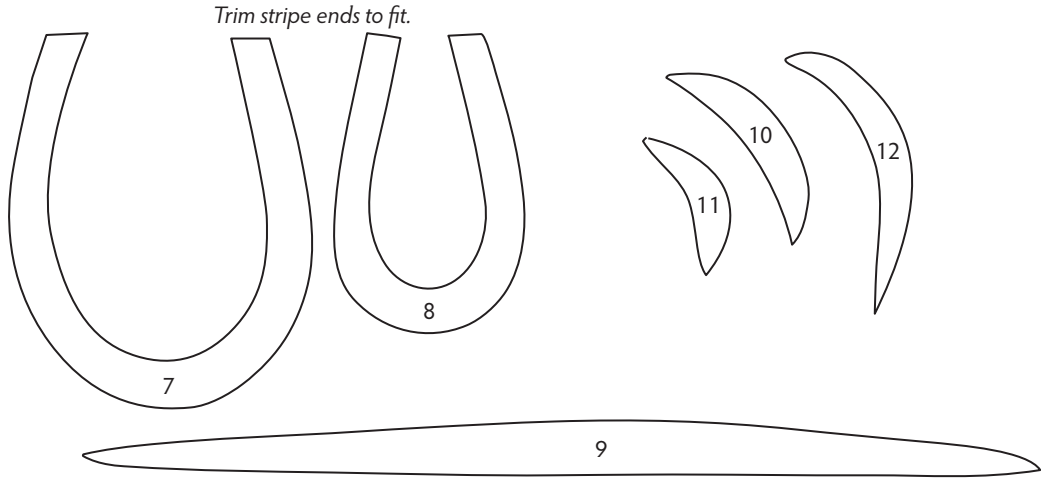

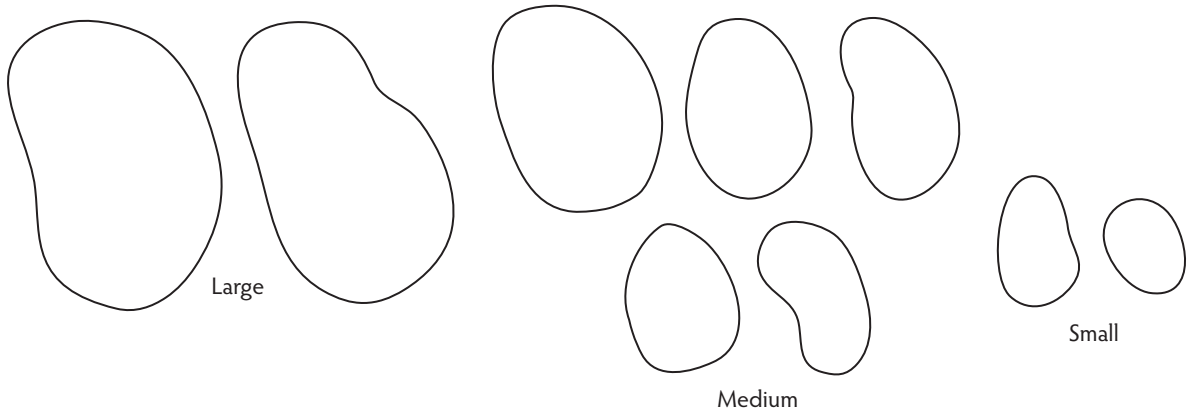

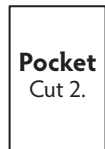

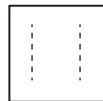
Giraffe spots
